



An Aloha Message to our Kapalua Bay Golfers

October 2021

We are excited to have you back! We want all of our valued golfers to know you can help us create an enjoyable and safe Bay Golf experience. To ensure everyone's health to the greatest possible degree, we are following the **COVID-19 Pandemic Guidelines** as mandated by the CDC, The Hawaii State Department of Health, The Mayor of Maui's Office, and the Aloha Section Professional Golfers' Association. As we endeavor to keep our island paradise safe, we ask for your kind cooperation by respecting the following guidelines:

1. **Social Distance** - Golfers **should maintain at least 6 feet of social distancing** at all times.

2. **Face coverings** - Golfers **must wear a face covering while inside all facilities.**

3. **Golf Bags** Unless requested not to touch your golf bag, our staff will load your bags onto the golf carts.

4. **Golfers** will be paired up with other golfers.

5. **Golf Carts** - If a golf cart is shared by two riders from different households, it is recommended that both riders wear a face covering while in the cart. Golf carts are sanitized pre round. Single carts are available for golfers over 60 years of age or for those who are deemed to be "High-Risk" per CDC criteria.

6. **Arrival Time and Departure** – To avoid gatherings, all golfers are requested to arrive **no more than 30 minutes** prior to their tee time and to leave as soon as possible after their round is completed.

7. **Flags** There are no flag restrictions. Players may remove the flag or play with the flag in per USGA rules.

8. **Golf Club Rentals** - Rental clubs and shoes are available. Please contact Reservations 808-669-8044 prior to your round.

9. **Cart/Course amenities** – We have removed rakes from our bunkers to improve the pace of play and to enhance player enjoyment. Balls in the bunker may be played as preferred lies. Bottled water is provided on the carts and water is available at the Bay Café Snack Shop. There is no on course water service.

10. **On-course Food & Beverage** – The Bay Café Snack Shop is open and is located after the 3rd hole and 12th hole. Hawaii State Law does not permit outside alcohol on the golf course.

11. **The Public Driving Range** opens at 9am and closes at 5pm. Tuesday, the range closes at 4pm and reopens at 8am on Wednesdays. On other days, golfers with tee times may warm starting at 7am.

12. **Restrooms** are located in the Village Center and after holes 3, 8, & 12.
